(Numbers do not include ferries for Fisher's Island or Block Island)

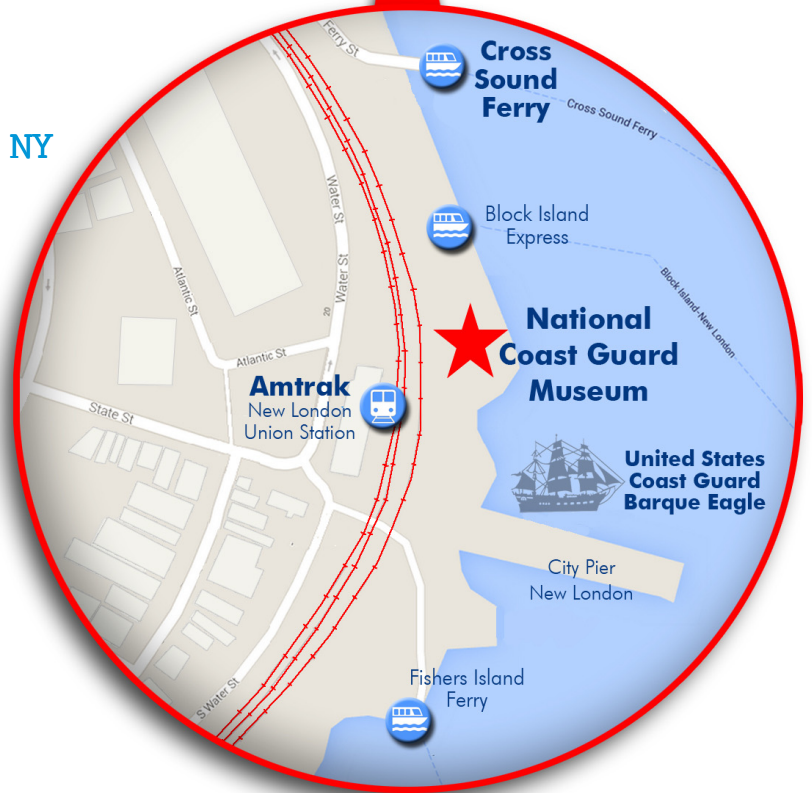
- **1.3 million** passengers annually
- **58 arrivals and departures daily** during peak summer travel season

RAIL

- Amtrak's Northeast Corridor is the busiest railroad in North America. More than **2,200 trains** run between Washington and Boston every day
- In 2012, **11.4 million** passengers traveled on the NEC between Washington, New York and Boston
- Amtrak carried more riders between New York and Boston than all of the airlines combined
- In 2012 the New London Amtrak station had **173,003 boardings**, accounting for roughly 10% of the passengers traveling via CT train lines
